What are Teacher Cards?

- ▶ A Teacher Card will allow you to check out materials which can be used to directly benefit your students and classroom. This card is NOT meant to be used as a personal library card. The materials and electronic resources are for in-class use only.
- ▶ Teacher Cards are thanks to an agreement between the libraries and local school district.

TEACHER CARD BENEFITS

- You don't have to use your personal public library card for materials you need for the classroom.
- We can supplement your instructional materials with items that you may not have access to through your school's library media center.
- The library can order multiple copies of a single title for classroom use.
- You'll not only have access to the library's print and physical collections, but you'll have access to your public library's digital collections, including eBooks and audio books, magazines and databases. Some libraries even have a Library of Things/Circulating Equipment!
- Materials will be checked out for 3 weeks. Items can be renewed if there has not been a hold placed on them by another library customer.
- Teacher Cards are valid for one school year.
- Teacher Cards may also be used for interlibrary loan materials. Interlibrary loan materials will be checked out according to the loan rule established by the lending library; this may be less than 3 weeks. Interlibrary loan material will be delivered to the public library where you received your card.

How Do I Apply for a Teacher Card?



Let your administrator know that you'd like a card. They'll add you to the list of eligible staff which will be shared with the public library.



Complete this brochure and take it to the public library that services your school. Please note that the library card registration process may vary by library.
